

April 2022 Release Notes


In addition to minor updates and bug fixes, significant updates from the April 2022 release will be highlighted below.

Product Updates

Restrict Flag for activities in Course Designer

FocalPoint has released a new feature in Course Designer communities that allows the ability to 'restrict' certain activities. In Virtual communities when the teacher publishes all activities, the 'restricted' activities will not be visible to students, by default. The teachers will need to manually publish them to make them available to students.

Once in your selected Course Designer community, you will see a new toggle next to the activities. By clicking the toggle, the 'restrict' feature will be activated



Once you've assigned the new learning objective in a Virtual community, the activity that was restricted in Course Designer will be unpublished, by default. In order for teachers to publish the assignment, they will need to click the Publish toggle on.



Public Backpack View

Realizing that blockchain credentialing is the future of education, FocalPoint has designed the ability for students to easily share a public backpack view. Students are now able to share this composite view as a link or a QR code. This composite view is a collective of all of the student's credentials in Backpack, in an easy to view format.



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Bug Fixes

Export Course Usage as PDF

We understand how important being able to track a student's course usage is. We discovered an issue some users were experiencing when they attempted to download course usage as a PDF. This issue is no more, and users can resume exporting course usage reports without interruption.

While in the Course Usage dashboard, simply click the three dots on the right side of the screen and select 'Export to PDF'

Required Activity Issue When Excused

Users may have noticed an issue when a required student activity is excused, then the next activity is not unlocking. This bug has been fixed, and now when a student is excused from a required activity, the next activity will automatically unlock so the student can access it as expected.

Seeing Student Activity Details in Speed Grader

Users may have noticed the activity details were showing empty while trying to score a student activity from Speed Grader from both the LearningTree home, and inside a learning community. Also, the count showing the number of activities needing to be graded was not showing on the initial load. These bugs have been fixed, and now graders can see the activity details, as well as the number of activities needing to be graded as expected.
