Product Updates

Classlink Added to the Login Screen

FocalPoint has added ClassLink as an option on the login screen.

FocalPointK12 supports Google, ClassLink and Clever logins.

Support for Course Providers to Restrict Courses to a Tenant

We have added the ability for Course Providers to restrict courses to a particular tenant.

- If a particular course is added to a community, then it can be removed from the future selections, but the current communities that have the course loaded will stay intact.
- The add/remove option only applies to future courses being added to communities.

Bug Fixes

Speed Grader - Discussion Activity Scoring

Users may have noticed a bug inside LearningTree's Speed Grader when the user scored a discussion activity, then went to the next discussion activity, either an empty pop-up was showing, or the user was unable to score the next activity. This issue has been resolved, and grading discussion activities in Speed Grader will function as expected.

June 2022 Release Notes

File Name Issue when Student Information is Exported

When a teacher or admin viewed student information and clicked on export, the file name of the downloaded spreadsheet had the teacher or admin's name instead of the student's name. This has been resolved, and now the student's name will appear as expected.

Community Members Not Showing

Users may have noticed that the list of members wasn't showing in communities. This has been fixed, and now the members will show under the members tab as expected.

Start Learning Skipping LTI Content Provider and External Tool Activities

Users may have noticed the Start Learning button was skipping over LTI content provider activities as well as external tool activities. This issue has been fixed, and now the Start Learning button will take students to these activities, if applicable, as expected.

Activity Progress Pop-Up Closing on Student Activity Reset

Users may have noticed that the activity progress pop-up was closing when they reset a student activity. This has been fixed, and now the activity progress pop-up will not close, and the student activity status will change to 'Not Started' when the activity is reset.
